**Position:** Youth Group Leader

- ❖ Supervise groups of young people to ensure their safety and well being
- ❖ Model the Christian life, and Authentic Christian relationships to youth group members
- ❖ Teach the Bible faithfully and truthfully
- ❖ Build relationships with students that promote belonging, inclusivity and connection.
- ❖ Encourage, pray and journey with members of the group
- ❖ Build connections with participant's families
- ❖ Report to Pastor any issues or problems

- Complete regular Safe Church Awareness and Leadership Training
- Minimum 6 months' attendance at Springwood Church of Christ
- Flexible and a good team player
- Attentive to young people and their needs
